




Virden Collegiate Institute had two courses working together, emphasizing teamwork and collaboration. Students plotted the garden using GPS, conducted soil tests, and designed a comparative-analysis plan with varying nutrient-application levels.

Through learning gardens, students explore how modern agriculture, gardening, plant growth, and nutrition work as a part of the global supply chain, and understand the valuable role nutrients play in food production, health, and sustainability.
